Goal Safety policy

GS-KSL-2005/2006

Community Center

- 1 All goals are to be pinned down at all times.
- 2 During the off season, goals should be stored along the fence line. The opening for the goal should be covered by the fence.

High School field

- 1 Goals should be weighed down by sand bags. These goals are constantly being moved.
- 2 During the off season, goals should be linked together back to back.

General Rules

- 1 Coaches for each game will inspect to make sure goals are securely anchored in accordance with CPSC guidelines.
- 2 Coaches for the last game will make sure goals are stored in accordance with CPSC guidelines/manufactorer's guidelines.
- 3 All coaches will receive CPSC guidelines and instructions as to how to make the goals safe.
- 4 Coaches will discuss with players, siblings and parent the necessity of not playing on or moving the goals. Players violating this rule may be suspended for a game.
- 5 President will have random site surveys to certify compliance.
- 6 President will certify to OYSAN no later than Nov. 1 of each year that this policy is in place and enforced.
- 7 Should Goals present a hazard, Coach will either correct hazard or suspend play.
